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## **Fatality Review Division**

The Fatality Review Internship Program provides field practicums in the field of human services (primarily social work, nursing, and public health). Under the guidance of OCME staff, interns will assist with writing comprehensive case summary reports and presenting these reports during meetings for the following review entities:

- Child Fatality Review Committee and Infant Mortality Review Team
- Maternal Mortality Review Committee
- Violence Fatality Review Committee
- Opioid Fatality Review Board

Interns will gain skills in data entry management, comprehensive report writing, analyzing multidisciplinary records, identifying trends, researching best practices for fatality prevention and additional program initiatives, and building relationships with various appointed members of fatality review committees and boards. The internship is a semester-long program, and interns are expected to be available two full days per week during regular business hours. Students enrolled in a graduate-level program in human services are eligible to apply.
