

Fatalities among the DC Undomiciled Population: January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2017¹



The District of Columbia Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) investigated a total of **251** deaths among the homeless/undomicilied population in the District from Jan. 1, 2013 through Dec. 31, 2017. Decedents were primarily Black (75%), Male (88%), and between the age of 50 to 69 (64%). The top 5 leading causes of death were responsible for 77% of the overall fatalities (highlighted in blue in Table 1). This report presents the trends and demographics among the homeless/undomicilied observed at the OCME between CY 2013 and CY 2017.


Total Number of Deaths






Age

Manner of Death


