TITLE: BUILDING MAINTENANCE

Policy: The Office of the Chief Medical Examiner's (OCME) policy is to establish a

standard level for facility maintenance in order to maintain a sanitary and

aesthetic work environment.

Purpose: The purpose of this standard operating procedure is to provide the requirements

for daily maintenance of the facility that houses the OCME.

Scope: The facility maintenance includes heating, ventilation, air conditioning, plumbing

and electrical systems which are to be effectively and efficiently operating at all

times.

1. GENERAL

1.1. The OCME is located in the Consolidated Forensic Laboratory (CFL) facility. Building maintenance is provided via a vendor through a District government-wide contractual arrangement.
