Policy: The Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) is assured adequate

supporting services, equipment and facilities to perform autopsy examinations

pursuant to DC Code § 5-1403 and 1409.

Purpose: The OCME provides all support or consultative services that may be necessary for

the medical examiner to fulfill their responsibility of determining cause and

manner of death.

Scope: The following procedures are to assist Medical Examiner physicians.

1. Toxicology

1.1. Toxicology services are provided in-house. The laboratory is accredited by the American Board of Forensic Toxicology. The Chief Toxicologist is certified by the American Board of Forensic Toxicology. The Deputy Chief Toxicologist has a doctoral degree in Postmortem Toxicology.
